Today's program was presented by East Portland Rotarian and Executive Director of the Union Gospel Mission, Bill Russell. The organization has been working with the homeless for generations, but today an outreach that used to be focused mainly on Portland's "Old Town" now extends to all corners of the city. Russell gave a hard-hitting talk, pointing out that Portland City Hall has been relatively ineffective in dealing with the problem; "70% of the homeless are disabled, including mentally disabled, or addicted to alcohol or drugs." He pointed out that "housing will not end homelessness. These people need a life that is self-sustaining. Many HAD housing and lost it because of these disabilities." The biggest need is addressing mental issues. UGM is working on it.



#### Lisa Allen acquaints us with Goodwill Northwest

At our October 8 meeting, our speaker was Asst. District Governor Lisa Allen (above), who also is with the area's Goodwill Industries – the primary mission of which, she told us, is "to help people find jobs". The local organization of the nonprofit had \$117.2 million in sales last year, and the local Goodwill organization is the "most profitable in the whole world". 81% of donated items are sold or recycled; the finest donated items are placed on the Goodwill website and sold online, so it's worth checking there! It was an interesting talk, and club members learned a lot about this organization.
